

### ENJOY CAMPUS EATS



### GET AROUND

All seven campus communities offer local public transit. In addition, Simcoe County Transit LINX and Hammond buses offer regional transportation. If you have a car, you can park on campus with a monthly pass or pay daily rates. The Barrie Campus uses the Honk mobile app for parking payments.

### FIND YOUR OWN PLACE

Whatever campus you're attending, [Places4Students.com](http://Places4Students.com) allows you to search local rental property listings. In addition, there are private residences nearby. In Barrie, some options include Foundry Georgian, Georgian Green, London Property Corp., and School House Barrie; in Orillia, there is Hilda House; and in Owen Sound there is Owen Sound Student Residence. Georgian doesn't inspect off-campus housing, so use due diligence when looking for accommodation.
