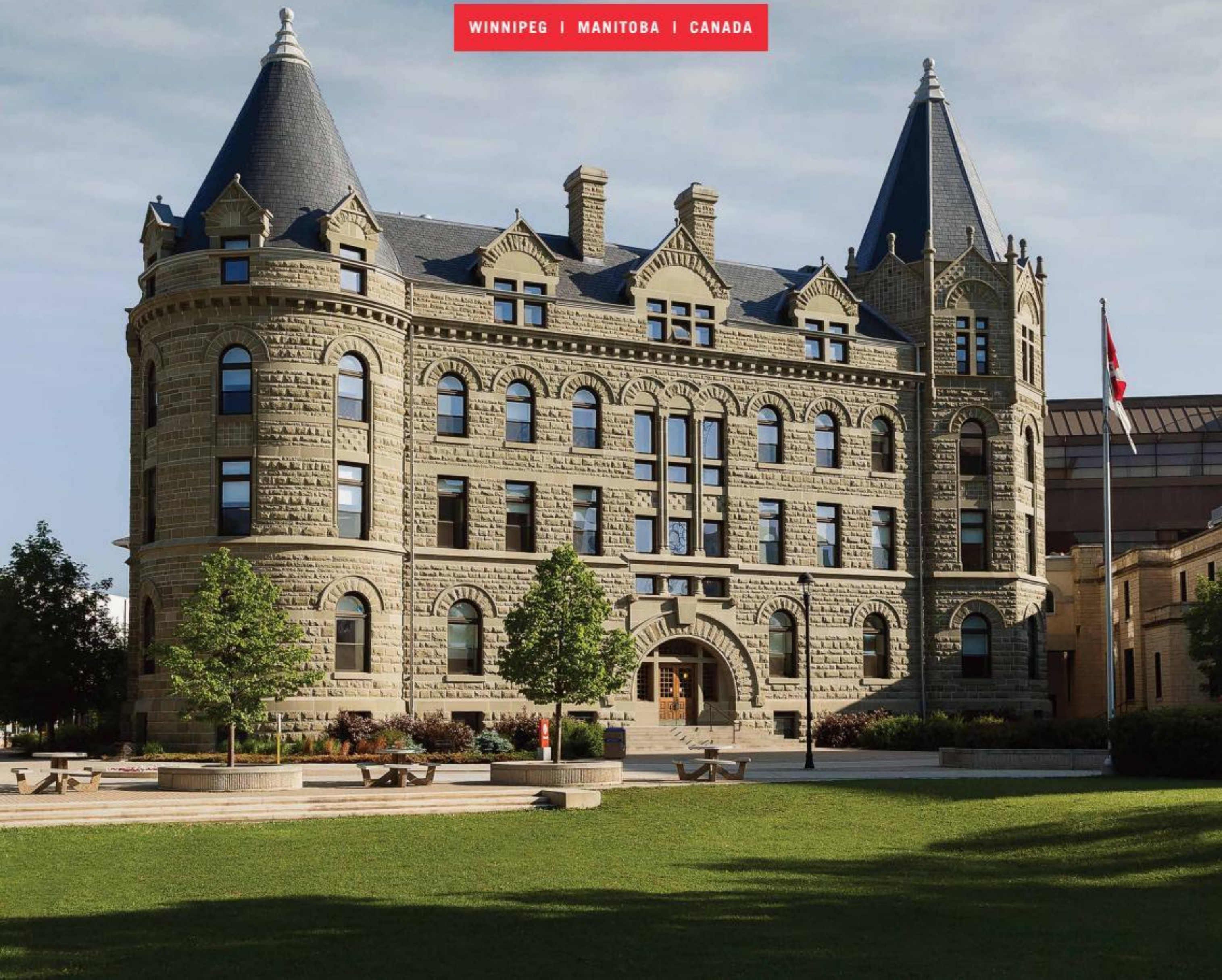

Earn While You Learn

Looking to make some money while you're a student? International students looking for part-time work have the option of working on campus, off campus or enrolling in a co-op work program in their field of study.

The Provincial Nominee Program offers incentive to those seeking to live and work in Manitoba after graduation.



WORK ON CAMPUS

International students who are registered full-time and have a valid study permit are eligible to work on campus in a variety of jobs, such as the campus bookstore and restaurants, athletic facilities and research assistants for professors.

There are also many job opportunities downtown near the University.

CAREER SERVICES

When you're ready to look for a job, whether it's a part-time job during your studies or your first career position, Career Services has advice on how to conduct a job search.

CO-OP AND INTERNSHIP PROGRAMS

Some of our academic programs include work experience as part of the curriculum. Students who wish to participate in a co-op or internship program must apply for a co-op work permit as well as a study permit.

WORK-STUDY PROGRAM

International students with a valid study permit are eligible for the Work-Study Program, which provides on-campus part-time job opportunities. There are a broad range of jobs to choose from.

The program provides work experience in your area of study, as a number of the positions are program related. Some recent positions include research assistant, assistant technician, and office assistant.

THE MANITOBA ADVANTAGE

Students who have completed an undergraduate degree at UWinnipeg are eligible for a post-graduation work permit, which offers the opportunity to work in Canada after graduation.

Immigrate to Canada

The Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program offers the opportunity for international student graduates to apply for permanent residence status in Canada.

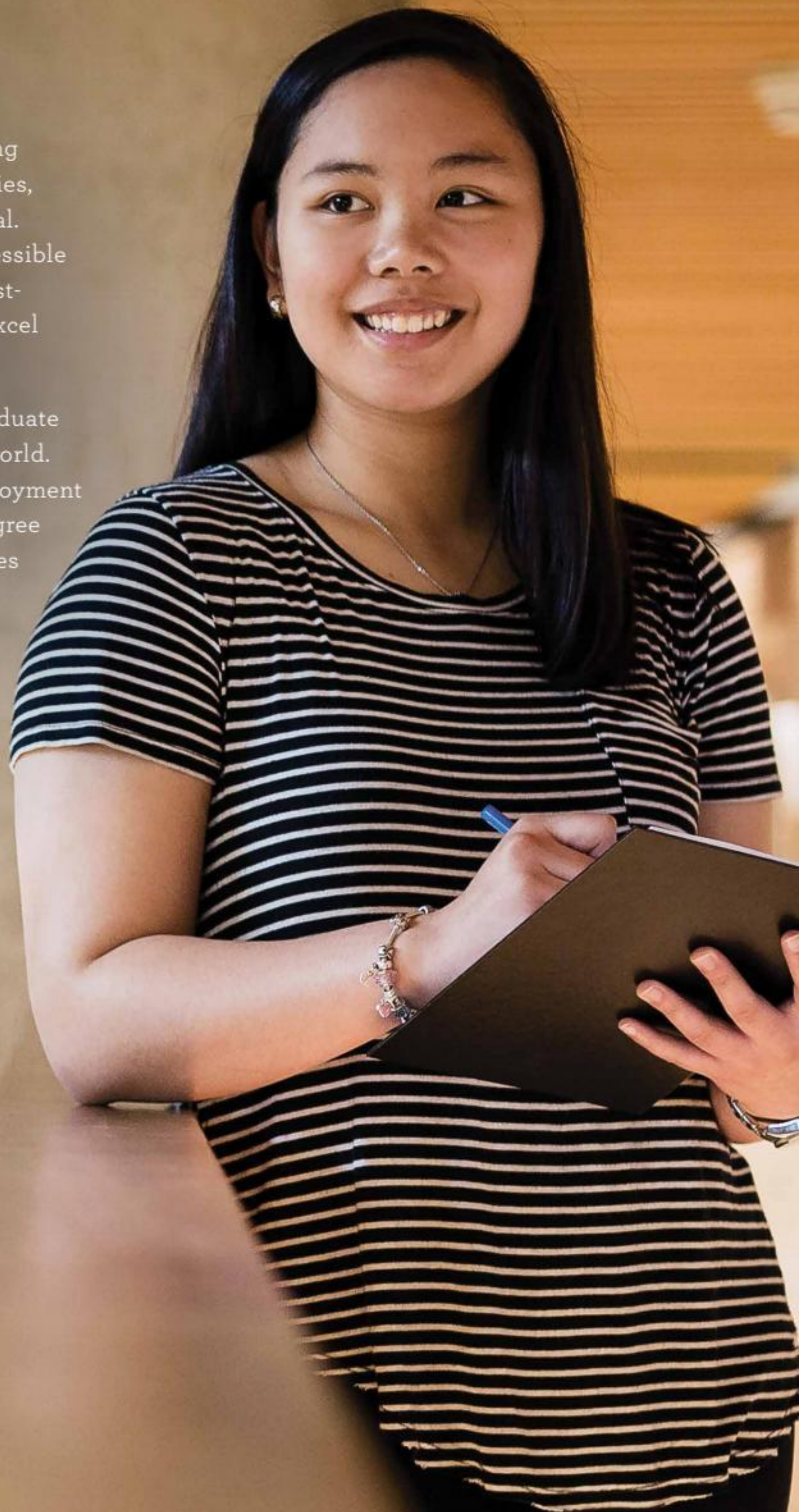

Scholarship Opportunities

The University of Winnipeg believes in fairness and equality. International students are eligible for the same awards opportunities as Canadian students. Values range from \$500–\$5,000. There are also some awards available to international students only.

PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP FOR WORLD LEADERS

This scholarship will be given to international students (including U.S. students) entering any of UWinnipeg's divisions for the first time. Candidates must be involved in activities that demonstrate leadership, have a minimum 80% admission average or equivalent, and entering the first year of any program.

TOEFL: Minimum score of 80 with no less than 19 in each component (Internet-based).

IELTS: Minimum band score of 6.5 based on the Academic Module.

CanTest: An average score of 4.5 in listening and reading, and a score of 4.0 in writing.

English Language Program (ELP)

The University of Winnipeg's English Language Program welcomes over 450 students from more than 30 countries each year. We offer a variety of programs: Academic and General English, Short Term Intensive English, Canadian Work Experience, ESL Teacher Certificate, and customized programs. We are accredited by Languages Canada, an authorized CanTEST (Canadian Test of English for Scholars and Trainees) test centre, and an IELTS test venue.



FULL-TIME PROGRAMS (14 WEEKS)

Academic/Pathway English Program

This program prepares you to enter Canadian universities, colleges, and targets all four language areas: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. You will improve your ability to read academic materials, write essays, take notes, listen to lectures, and give presentations — skills you will need to be successful in a Canadian university.

When you complete the highest level of this program, you will meet the English Language Proficiency Requirement for admission to UWinnipeg's undergraduate degree programs, select graduate programs, and Professional, Applied and Continuing Education (PACE), as well as earn university credit hours that can be applied to further study at UWinnipeg.

General English Program

This program enables you to advance your English language skills for personal and professional purposes, and targets all four language areas: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. You will participate in a variety of seminars such as vocabulary, TOEFL and IELTS preparation, reading, writing, conversation, and pronunciation.

Foundations English Program

This program prepares you to enter our Academic/Pathway or General programs. If you're beginning with a low to intermediate English level you'll start in the Foundations stream of the program.

SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS

Intensive English Programs

This 4–5 week program will provide you with a short, intensive English language learning experience to help advance your educational or career goals.

Our program is designed to accelerate your communication development with classes that focus on the core skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing; conversation classes to build vocabulary; and a variety of cultural and academic workshops to improve speaking ability. Weekly socio-cultural activities are also a great way for you to practice your new language skills while exploring Winnipeg.

Canadian Work Experience Programs

This 7-week English program offers four weeks of classroom study followed by a 3-week volunteer placement, giving you the opportunity to speak English in a Canadian work environment. Types of placements include architecture firms, museums, libraries, radio stations, youth centres, athletic facilities, art galleries, health care facilities, restaurants, retail stores, and non-profit businesses. Students also participate in after-class socio-cultural activities to practice their informal English skills.

The recommended language levels for prospective students are TOEFL: iBT 61, IELTS: 5.5 overall, TOEIC: 800, or equivalent ELP program score.

OPPORTUNITIES TO EXCEL

Seamless Admission to The University of Winnipeg

Graduating Collegiate students who meet entrance requirements to The University of Winnipeg automatically receive seamless admission into undergraduate studies. They will receive an offer of acceptance from UWinnipeg in January before being offered formal admission in April, when final grade 12 marks are available.

Dual Credit Courses

Qualified students can accelerate their learning by taking dual-credit courses in their grade 12 year. These are introductory first-year university courses that students can use for credit toward both their high school diploma and an eligible university degree.

University Foundation Program

International students who have earned a high school diploma in their home country — but do not meet university entrance requirements — can complete the Foundation Program at UWC. Students will complete five grade 12 courses to earn a Manitoba high school diploma, and upon successful completion students will be eligible to apply to universities or colleges.

UWC closely conforms to the UWinnipeg academic year, providing students with a more adequate preparation for university studies. The Fall/Winter (Sept–April) and Spring (May–June) sessions offer both day and evening courses.

That is why we have a dedicated Scholarship Office to assist students with their applications for scholarships and awards for post-secondary studies, wherever it is they choose to study. HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

This program is designed to help students develop the practical, theoretical, and specific skills needed to work in a human resource function. It combines highly relevant leadership, business and communication essentials with core HR requirements.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

This program provides an analytical framework coupled with essential project management tools for budgeting, procuring, scoping, modeling, measuring, and reporting for a broad business application. Given the challenges facing business today, organizations are better positioned to thrive by hiring talent that can drive the business solution process and strengthen growth opportunities.

PUBLIC RELATIONS, MARKETING AND STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS

This program will prepare students to work as a public relations and/or marketing practitioner in a corporate or not-for-profit environment. The courses provide a broad foundation of PR and marketing-specific knowledge and skills with an emphasis on best practices, and current and emerging issues. The PR and marketing sectors are areas with high growth potential and considerable opportunity.

Graduates of this program will receive both the Public Relations Diploma and the Management Certificate.

MARKETING MANAGEMENT

This program prepares students to work in a marketing capacity with the theoretical foundation and a blend of marketing tools, systems and strategies to add economic value to any organization.

WEB DEVELOPMENT

This program provides exposure to a wide variety of Internet-related technologies including front end client-side (XHTML, CSS, JavaScript, Flash, Photoshop), back-end programming, and databases (PHP, ASP.net, Java, MySQL), as well as the topics that tie them all together (Linux, Windows, Apache, TCP/IP, security, and more). The course is capped off with a cumulative e-commerce project and work experience placement with one of many participating companies and businesses.

NETWORK SECURITY

This diploma program blends hands-on learning with theoretical elements of IT security. Graduates will have an in-depth knowledge of, and training in, various protocols, network standards, designs and security solutions. The program assists graduates in preparing for the CISCO CCNA designation, an internationally and industry recognized professional certification.

Graduates of this program receive the Network Security Diploma, an Information Assurance Certificate and a Management Certificate.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

The Financial Management Diploma Program emphasizes sustainable business approaches within a comprehensive financial framework to develop individuals who can solve complex business problems and improve organizational performance in an ever-changing business.

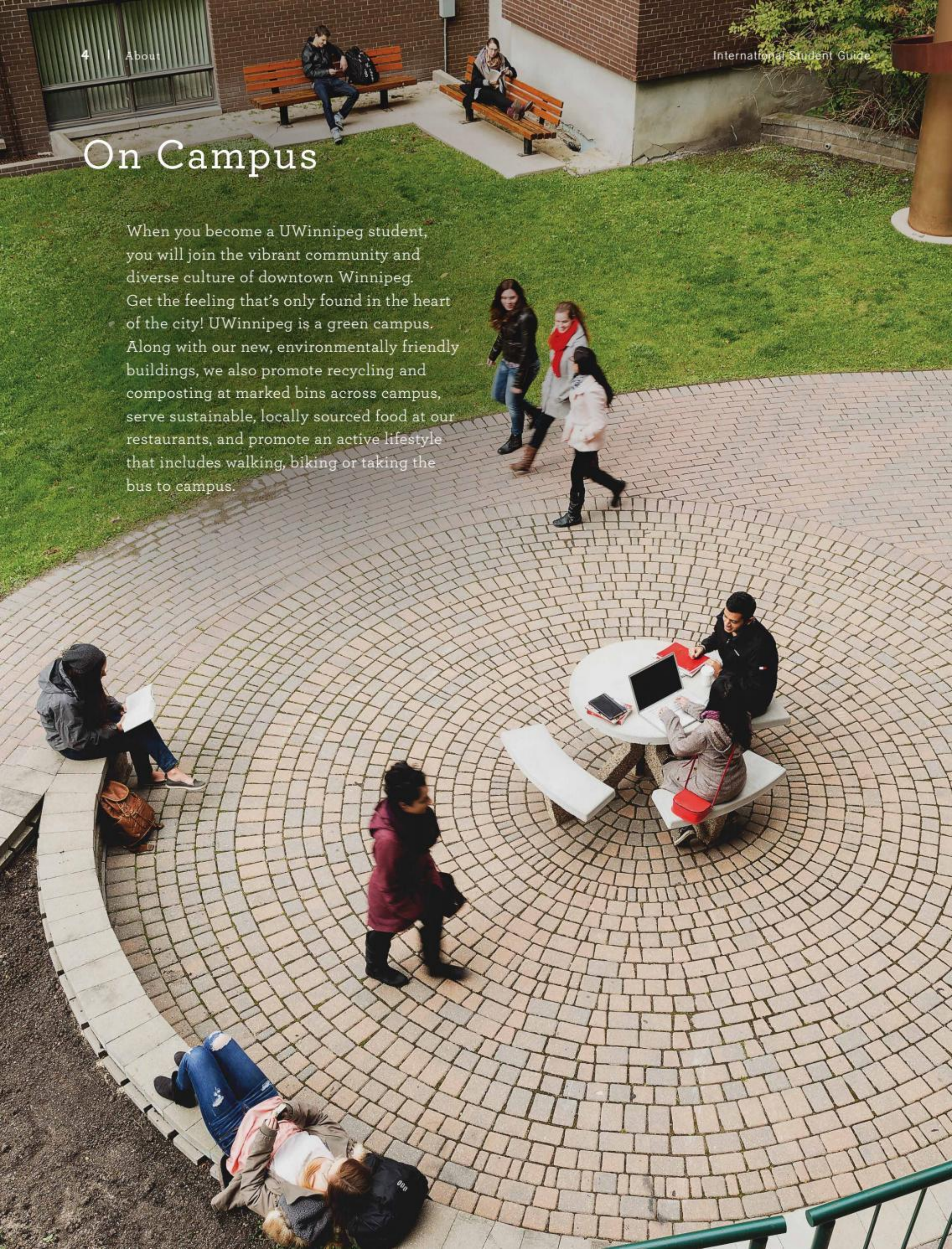
