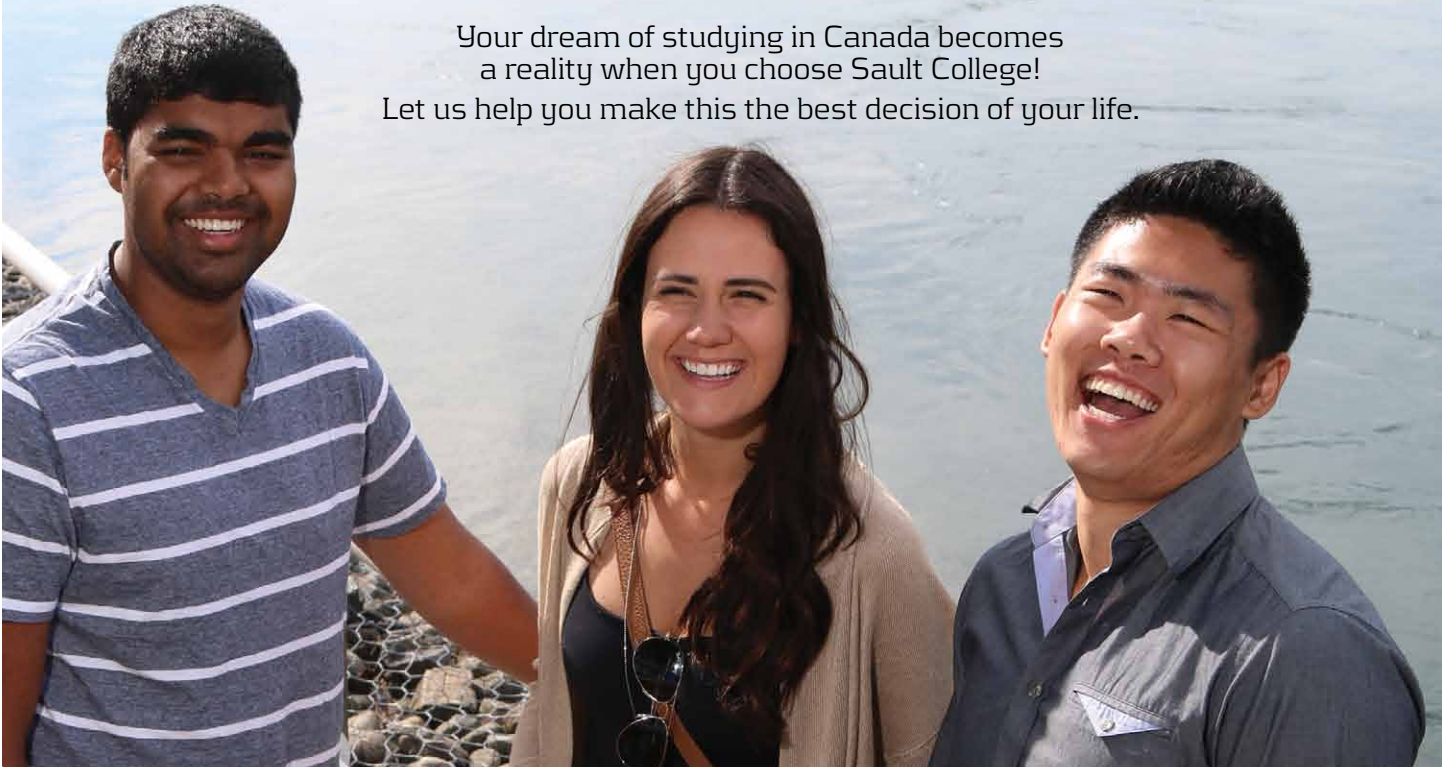

Scan copies of your secondary/high school transcript (and College/University transcript, if applicable) as well as other official documents such as English language proficiency and exam results

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If English is not your first language, send the results of your English language proficiency test (IELTS) with your application.

Once you've received a letter of acceptance, pay your deposit to confirm your acceptance. Then, you will receive your detailed acceptance information so you can apply for a Canadian Study Permit (Form IMM1294). ## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

**TO STUDY** at Sault College, you need to complete secondary school (high school) and meet our English language proficiency requirements. Some programs require additional courses in Math and Sciences.

# ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Completion of at least 3 years of secondary/high school taught exclusively in the medium of English.

## 2

**(a)** Overall IELTS score of 6.0 with no band lower than 5.5 with test results within the last two years; an overall IELTS score of 6.5 is required for the Pharmacy Technician program  
**(b)** Other acceptable tests of English proficiency (depending on your country of application)  
 TOEFL (80 lbt, 213 cbt, 550 pbt)  
 PTE - 60  
 TOEIC – Gold (860-990)

## 3

Completion of an acceptable college-preparatory English as a Second Language program or Sault College's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program.

## ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP) PROGRAM

If you meet all the admission requirements for your program of choice except for the English language requirement, you qualify for conditional admission. You will be admitted to Sault College with the condition to first complete EAP. EAP has continuous intake year-round. Each semester is 14 weeks with approximately 25 hours of instruction per week. All students have access to free 'peer tutoring'. This is a great way to meet other students and improve your success.

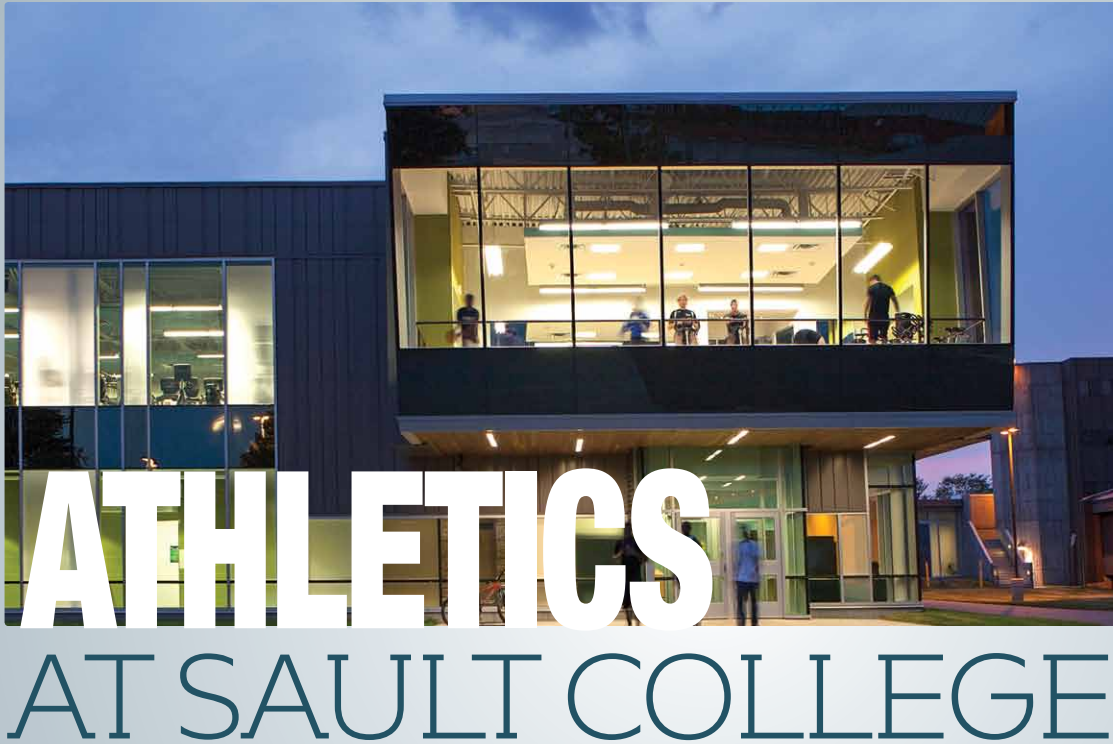
Tutorial service is led by the faculty for students requiring help with writing, reports, resumes, research and documentation.

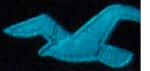
## SAULT COLLEGE PLACEMENT SERVICES

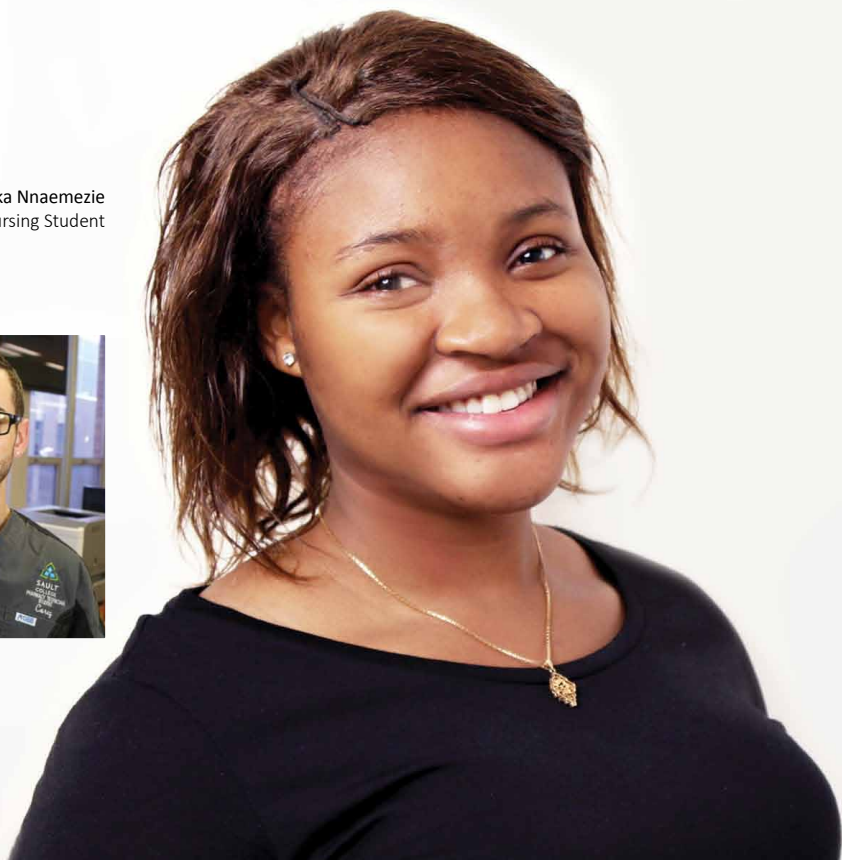
