


## Strengthen your language skills and gain Canadian experience before entering one of our programs of study.

# Your journey

## Application

Make Mohawk your first choice! Research your favourite programs to help you make the best decision. Check the admission requirements as they are specific to individual programs.

You can submit an application online, or by email, fax, posted mail, and in-person.



## Pre-departure

Meet online or by phone with your Mohawk College Student Mentor and learn what to expect during your stay at Mohawk and in Hamilton, Canada.

While preparing for your trip, consider flights, in-country travel, and living accommodations.



## Acceptance

Offers of admission are sent to applicants who have been accepted into their programs of choice.

You must pay the tuition deposit to secure your seat before the expiry date on your offer letter. Please apply for your study permit/visa as soon as you can.



## Arrival in Canada and at Mohawk College

You can arrange to be greeted by a Mohawk College staff upon arrival at Toronto Pearson International Airport, and you will be assisted with luggage and transportation directly to your accommodations.





## Registration and Orientation

Once you receive your study permit and have paid your tuition fees for your program, you will be able to register for your courses online.



## Step 2: Prepare your Application Package

1. Complete and sign the application form found at [mohawkcollege.ca/IntlApplication](http://mohawkcollege.ca/IntlApplication)
2. Applications must include:
  - Passport – Picture and address pages
  - Academic documents (exempted for applicants who want to study English only)
  - Translated and notarized transcripts from high school (secondary school) and higher education institute (if applicable)
  - Translated and notarized diploma(s)/degree(s) from high school (secondary school) and higher education institute (if applicable)
  - Official IELTS / TOEFL result or English grade 12 credit from a Canadian secondary school (if applicable)
  - \$100 CAD Application Fee (Non-Refundable)
