



PAY A PORTION

The Queensland Government will offset the cost of study for people who don't currently have a qualification. Evidence of subsidy eligibility is required at time of enrolment.

STUDY NOW, PAY LATER!

TAFE Queensland students can now access VET FEE-HELP which is a financial assistance loan scheme, available to assist eligible students studying higher level Vocational Education and Training (VET) qualifications to pay their tuition fees.

PAYMENT PLANS

TAFE Queensland offers an interest free payment plan option to approved students allowing them to pay their fees in instalments over the duration of their study. Plans are only offered through Direct Bank Debit contracts and a deposit is required at time of enrolment. Terms and conditions apply.

CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE

If eligible you will receive subsidised training for one certificate III level qualification from a list of eligible courses.

FEE-FREE TRAINING FOR YEAR 12 GRADUATES

Are you a Queensland resident? Have you just finished year 12? You might be eligible for Fee-Free training. The Queensland Government will pay the full cost of a number of eligible certificate III qualifications in high-priority study areas under the Certificate 3 Guarantee and User Choice programs.

HIGHER LEVEL SKILLS SUBSIDY (HLS)

This initiative is a one-off subsidy that offsets the cost of a certificate IV or higher course. Students will need to co-contribute to the payment of the course. The level of government subsidy depends on the demand for workers in your chosen field. Eligibility criteria does apply



FEE CONCESSION

Eligible students are entitled to a fee concession on Queensland Government funded programs. For more information or to find out if you meet the criteria visit the **tafeeastcoast.edu.au** website.






