Apply online at udayton.edu/apply/international. Because the University of Dayton is a member of the Common Application group, you can also apply through the Common Application. There is no application fee.



Application Deadline

Fall Term (August – December)	May 1
Spring Term (January – April)	November 1
Summer Term (May – July)	Case-by-case basis

We will continue to process complete applications received after the deadline; however, we cannot guarantee an admission decision will be reached in time to begin the desired term.

To apply to the University of Dayton, you must send:

- Application, including the essay.
- Letter of recommendation.
- Official secondary transcript (in the language of original issue) of all previously attended secondary schools, including dates of attendance, all subjects studied, grades earned and marks achieved on examinations; any transcripts not issued in English must be accompanied by a certified English translation.
- Students entering the U.S. on an F-1 or J-1 visa must provide a letter of financial support and a bank statement showing sufficient funds to cover the first year of study before immigration documents can be issued.
- TOEFL score (or equivalent).
