Sunrise - An Overview

Sunrise Aviation in Ormond Beach, Florida has been in operation continuously since 1983. We are located at Ormond Beach Municipal Airport in Central Florida just 7 miles north of Daytona Beach and only an hour's drive from Orlando.

Sunrise Aviation has trained pilots from all over the world during the past 30 years. We pride ourselves on providing quality flight instruction while giving each student individual attention. While holding our students and instructors to the highest safety standards, we finish our students on-time and within budget. To accomplish this, we maintain a low student to instructor ratio and as many aircraft as necessary to complete your training as promised. The exceptional flying weather in Central Florida permits VFR flying more than 350 days each year. Accelerated flight training is also just a small part of the Sunrise package!

Sunrise Aviation owns and maintains its own fleet of aircraft. We have the largest fleet of Cessna 152s in Florida and approximately 100 aircraft. Since we are also a full-service FBO, our aircraft are fueled by our own staff and available for flight when you need them. Our well-trained and certified staff of aviation maintenance technicians is on duty constantly to keep your aircraft safe and ready to fly at your convenience.

Sunrise Aviation is approved by the FAA to offer training under Part 141 of the Federal Aviation Regulations. However, we hold the needs of the student as paramount and also offer training under the flexibility of Part 61 as well.

Sunrise Aviation is approved by the US Department of Homeland Security to accept foreign students for flight training. We provide all the forms and assistance necessary for international students to receive the M-1 visa and travel to the USA for that training.

Sunrise Aviation professional pilot packages include the FAA medical exam, FAA knowledge tests, and FAA flight exams. There are no hidden fees or extras in our commercial pilot training packages. We make all the arrangements in advance so that you do not need to wait. Sunrise Aviation fulfills the personal needs of the students as well. We offer training programs that include housing and transportation, or will help students make those arrangements on their own.

Sunrise Aviation offers training in Technically Advanced Aircraft and simulators with glass-cockpits. We will also tailor any of our flight training packages to meet your specific needs.

For many years Sunrise Aviation has trained international students seeking professional pilot training in preparation for a career as an airline pilot. We have specialized programs to meet the needs of students from many countries. Students at Sunrise Aviation are from Europe, Asia, Africa, and the USA. Our standard of instruction meets the needs of international airline pilot training.

When you are not at the airport, Sunrise Aviation is close to many local attractions. The Atlantic Ocean and some of the most beautiful beaches in the world are just a few miles away. Ormond Beach Municipal Airport (KOMN)



Ormond Beach Municipal Airport (KOMN) is owned and operated by the City of Ormond Beach, Florida. The airport is located on 1,128 acres of land just east of Interstate 95, north of the Tomoka River and west of U.S. Highway 1.

Ormond Beach Municipal Airport was first established in 1943 as a naval aviation training field. The airport, like many other smaller military airports in Florida, was deeded to the city in 1959 by the Federal Government. The airport facility offers two intersecting runways 8/26 and 17/35, which are 4,004 feet and 3,701 feet long respectively. It also offers six taxiways that are fully lighted.

There are approximately 170 aircraft based at the airport with approximately 127,000 annual operations (takeoffs or landings). The airport is designated by the Federal Aviation administration as a publicly owned, public-use general aviation facility.

The airport is served by an FAA funded Air Traffic Control Tower. Class D airspace surrounds the airport during the times the tower is open. Pilots should watch out for the overlying Class C airspace extending out from Daytona Beach International Airport.

The airport has both VOR and GPS approaches making it useful for instrument training as well as VFR training with quick access to nearby VFR practice areas.

There are many airports nearby both controlled and uncontrolled. Four airports are located within just 17 nm. Many other airports are located within easy cross-country distance.

Students needing experience at some of the busiest airports in the world have easy access to Daytona Beach International Airport, Orlando-Sanford International Airport, Orlando International Airport, Jacksonville International Airport, Tampa International Airport and even Miami International Airport.

The Sunrise Training Fleet

Sunrise Aviation currently has over 70 aircraft in its growing fleet. The fleet covers the needs of students seeking aircraft for training from private pilot to airline transport pilot. The fleet even includes the now sometimes difficult to find single-engine, complex aircraft still needed for certain ratings. With the *largest fleet of Cessna 152s* of any flight school in Florida plus a fleet of 6 multi-engine aircraft including the Piper Seneca fulfilling the need for a multi -engine aircraft approved by the DCGA in India, Sunrise Aviation is ready to fulfill your individual flight training or rental goal. Recent additions to the fleet include several **Cessna 172 SP Nav III** with Garmin G-1000 glass cockpits. These **Technically Advanced Aircraft** are great instrument trainers and excellent preparation for flight in today's airliners.



The **Cessna 152** is a two-seat, fixed tricycle gear, general aviation airplane. It provides both the performance and fuel economy needed in this class of aircraft. Sunrise Aviation has more than **30 C152s** in its fleet with many painted in the new fleet colors and with new seats and interiors. Several of the **C152s** are equipped for IFR training and many now have GPS. It is the most economical choice as your primary flight training aircraft.

Sunrise Aviation has a variety of **Cessna 172** models that will suit any student's needs. From our economical **C172M** model, to the more modern **2005 C172 R**, to the most recent **2008 C172 SP** with all-glass cockpit **G-1000** avionics, students can select the exact aircraft that they need to meet their training requirements. The **C172** is a four seat, single engine, tricycle gear, high wing airplane. The **C172** is the choice for heavier or taller students who find the smaller C152 uncomfortable.

The Sunrise Training Fleet

Piper Arrow - When you must have a single-engine retractable (complex) aircraft to complete your training (commercial single or CFI single) or just are looking for a trainer to ease the transition to the more complex twin engine aircraft, then Sunrise Aviation's **Piper Arrow I** (PA28R-180) is the perfect choice.



Sunrise has both **Piper Seminoles** and **Piper Seneca** multi-engine aircraft available for flight training. Either aircraft is a good choice for a twin-engine trainer. The Seneca is especially useful for students from India or other countries that require it for the multi-engine training. Sunrise also has a multiengine Flight Training Device (Frasca 142) that may be used in certain programs.

The **Piper Seminole** (PA-44-180) is the most popular multi-engine trainer worldwide. The **Piper Seminole** is a four place, low wing light twin aircraft with 180 hp engines.



The **Piper Seneca** (PA-34-200) is a six seat, twin engine, low wing airplane. The engines are 200 horsepower each. The **Seneca** adds power and performance while still retaining the safety of counter-rotating propellers.

Accommodation at Sunrise

There are many options for your accommodations while you are training at **Sunrise**. If you would like us to make all the arrangements, you may choose to stay in the **Sunrise Accommodation**. If you would like to arrange your own apartment, condo, or house, there are thousands of other local options, too. If your training period is only for a few days or a few weeks, then you might select one of the **hotel or motel options**. Whichever you prefer, the counselors at Sunrise Aviation will assist you to find the best alternative for you.

Sunrise Aviation leases many apartments to serve all the students who prefer Sunrise Aviation to arrange for their housing accommodations. If you choose this option, Sunrise Aviation will also arrange for **daily transportation** in our shuttle bus to and from the airport. We will also arrange for other necessary trips such as to the Aviation Medical Examiner for your FAA Medical Exam, routine shopping, etc. All of our houses are located in Ormond Beach and within a short driving distance of the airport.

Sunrise Aviation apartments located in Integra Shores and are **furnished**. The housing is set as 2 bedroom 2 bathroom apartments where each student gets their own bedroom and bathroom. Each apartment has a living room with television, dining room, and kitchen. Students share the kitchen facilities, but the house is fully equipped so that you can cook all your meals at home. Each house is equipped having cable and internet which the students split the cost of each month along with the usage fees for electric and water.



The cost of staying in one of the Sunrise Aviation accommodation; which includes transportation, is \$925.00 per month and a 6 month lease is required. A nonrefundable deposit for one month's rent is taken immediately; when housing is selected during the enrollment process, as a deposit from the initial tuition payment.

When staying in Sunrise accommodation a \$575 deposit is required when you move in. The cost of repairs and cleaning will be deducted from that deposit upon your departure. A standard deduction for cleaning at departure as well as linens will apply.
