Athletic scholarships in the amount of \$15,500 are available to select student-athletes—including international students—who demonstrate superior athletic abilities and meet the NAIA regulations and Fisher College regulations for eligibility.

In addition, we offer intramural opportunities through reduced-fee membership at a nearby fitness center. Every one of our student athletes commits to the NAIA core values of Respect, Responsibility, and Sportsmanship, while learning valuable lessons about teamwork along the way.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

You'll need to complete these steps to apply to Fisher College:

- Visit www.fisher.edu/apply to apply online, or request a paper application by calling +1 617.236.8820.
- Submit a \$50 application fee.
- Provide a copy of your passport.
- Ask your secondary school to send us your official, English-translated transcript (we can't accept copies).
- Submit your Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) results, or equivalent:
 - PTE Academic
 - IELTS Exam
 - Cambridge PET Exam
 - The STEP Eiken Exam (Japan)
 - The ESwPT Exam (Korea)
 - iTEP Academics: The International Test of English Proficiency (iTEP) with a minimum score of Level 5 or higher. The iTEP score is valid for two years.
- Provide a notarized, current bank statement verifying a minimum of \$52,000 U.S. Dollars in a cash account available for your use—required by consulates to confirm you can pay for your studies. If the account is not in your name, please also send a notarized letter of support from the holder of the account.
- (If transferring)* Send official college transcripts and written course descriptions.
- (If transferring from an American college or language school)* Send a Transfer Release Form and a copy of your I-20 from the last college you attended. You must be in good academic standing, owe no money to your previous college, and have no judicial or criminal complaints against you.
