



In addition to SU's beautiful grounds, there are a collection of state-of-the-art buildings designed to help you excel. SU enhanced academics and athletics with two new facilities in 2016. The Guerrieri Academic Commons revolutionizes how you think about libraries, and the new Sea Gull Stadium is among the best complexes in NCAA Division III.



Distinctive Difference

Salisbury University has been transformed by its quest for academic excellence. From its humble beginnings as a school for teachers, and later a relaxed regional college by the beach, in the last two decades, SU has launched itself into regional prominence as a powerhouse academic institution.

Over the last 15 years, the University has doubled in size, become a top producer of Fulbright faculty and been designated by the National Science Foundation (NSF) as a center for undergraduate research. Started over 35 years ago, SU's Honors Program has evolved into an Honors College, offering expanded learning opportunities in all disciplines. Opened in fall 2016, the Guerrieri Academic Commons library facility is the largest academic building in SU's history and changes the face of learning on campus.

SU attracts some of the best students in the region. In the past seven years, the average SAT of incoming students has risen by 87 points, and the average weighted GPA has climbed to over 3.75. SU boasts the highest four-year and six-year graduation rate and fastest time-to-degree completion of any of the comprehensive universities in the University of Maryland System.

Four Schools & One College

— *A Million Opportunities*

Perdue School of Business

- Perdue Hall, home of the Eastern Shore's premier center for entrepreneurship, features some \$3.1 million in new technology and is LEED gold certified.
- In 2016, the annual Perdue Entrepreneurship competition had a prize pool of nearly \$100,000 in start-up capital for students with the best new business proposals.
- In 2015, the Perdue School served as one of the national host locations for ABC's *Shark Tank* for the second year.
- It is among only 5 percent of business schools world-wide to be AACSB accredited, and its American Marketing Association chapter has been named one of the top 20 in the country.

Seidel School of Educational and Professional Studies

- SU has produced some 50 Maryland Teachers of the Year since 2003, including two statewide winners.
- Education has received three national awards for its leadership in professional development schools.
- SU offers the only accredited exercise science program in Maryland, featuring built-in internships.
- The Social Work Department offers B.S.W. and M.S.W. programs across the state and in Europe.

Fulton School of Liberal Arts

- The school features an innovative four-credit curriculum, which provides academic and experiential "enhancements" to courses in the humanities, social sciences and fine arts.
- SU is one of only two schools nationally to offer both an undergraduate and graduate degree in conflict analysis and dispute resolution and has the only approved "hot glass" art concentration within the state.

- Named one of *The Princeton Review's* "Great Schools for Communication Majors," SU has an 18,500 square foot Integrated Media Center for media and music production.
- The school's newest department in environmental studies has produced multiple Environmental Protection Agency Fellowship winners.

Henson School of Science and Technology

- The largest of the four SU schools, Henson develops leaders for science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) and health science fields.
- The school's focus on undergraduate research, including National Science Foundation summer research opportunities, has helped a recent student secure a coveted Gates-Cambridge Fellowship.
- SU's nursing program is widely regarded as one of the best in the region and our graduates have the highest pass rates in the University System of Maryland on the national nursing certification exams (NCLEX).
- SU offers a Medical Simulation Center and a host of research opportunities both internationally and throughout the natural laboratory of the Delmarva Peninsula.

Honors College

- The Honors College is designed to bring together high-achieving students and dedicated faculty from all four schools in a small university environment.
- The college offers motivated students who are serious about their intellectual growth a variety of special enhanced classes on interesting and unique subjects.
- Honors courses and extracurricular activities enrich and complement other educational opportunities and programs available to all SU students.
- Students have the opportunity to work closely with faculty members on individualized research.



Experience Excellence And Value

Salisbury University delivers a superb education at a great value. For well over a decade, SU has been among the *U.S. News & World Report's* and *Princeton Review's Best Colleges*. Since 2008, SU has been recognized among *Kiplinger's Personal Finance* magazine's "100 Best Value Public Colleges" and in 2014 was named to the top 25 list of "Best College Values Under \$30,000." *Kiplinger's* applauded SU's "high four-year graduation rate, low average student debt at graduation, abundant financial aid, low sticker price, and overall value." SU also was listed in the *Princeton Review's* "Top 80 Best Values in Public Colleges," which noted its "stellar academic programs coupled with the benefits of a state school price tag."



Applying

If you think that Salisbury University could be that right fit for you, then apply! Submit your application and essay online:

www.salisbury.edu/apply

Salisbury is also a member of the Common Application. Request that your official high school transcript and letter(s) of recommendation be sent to SU. Have your standardized test scores sent directly from either the College Board (SAT) or the American College Testing (ACT) Program. You are also welcome to send along additional material you feel would supplement your application.

Application Deadlines

- Early Decision (Binding): November 15 (December 15 Response)
- Early Action: December 1 (January 15 Response)
- Regular Decision: January 15 (March 15 Response)
- Transfer for Fall: March 1 (Priority deadline on a space-available basis)
- Transfer for Spring: October 1 (Priority deadline on a space-available basis)

Test-Optional Policy

Salisbury University is the only institution in the Maryland state system to offer test-optional admission. Some students' test scores are not an accurate reflection of their potential success at the college level. If you have a cumulative 3.5 weighted GPA on a 4.0 scale, you can elect not to submit test scores with your application. Admission is competitive within the group of test-optional candidates, so we suggest you provide materials to highlight your successes and the contributions you can make to the SU community.

Financing Your Education

Paying for college is a big investment. Fortunately, Salisbury University is widely recognized as a great return on that investment by national guidebooks. SU provides an exceptional education at one of the lowest prices of any university in the State of Maryland and lower than the in-state tuition of several neighboring states.

SU is your partner in meeting your educational goals. Our Financial Aid Office provides informational resources and assistance as you navigate the financial aid process. To qualify for need-based aid, all students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available beginning October 1. We encourage students to apply early for best consideration.

Applicants are also considered for a wide range of academic scholarships simply by applying. Some scholarships are awarded on academic credentials alone, but others also consider factors such as a student's major or area of residence. For more details about financial aid visit:
